Theft of Rawhide Portable Corral Newton County, MO 01/23/2017

Incident Date: 01/20/2017

Location: Hwy CC, Newton County, MO

Description of Incident:

The pictured subjects entered the Springdale, Arkansas Walmart at 01:59, on January 20, 2017, and purchased bolt cutters then left in the pictured white vehicle at 02:07. At 03:47, a dually flatbed truck entered a property on CC Hwy, north of 60 Hwy, in Newton County, Missouri, by cutting the lock and chain from the gate. A Rawhide portable corral purchased in October 2016, was taken from the property. The truck left the location and was caught on camera turning west from CC Hwy onto 60 Hwy in the direction of Oklahoma.

The victim states that he had an encounter with three subjects which he believes two were the suspects in December of 2016, when they pulled into his driveway in a green car with Kansas tags. At that time, the corral was not at the property and was only brought back to the property on January 8, 2017. The corral was purchased from a factory in Abilene, Kansas, and there are no other corrals with the exact same features in the area. The receipt and other items from the transaction at the Springdale Walmart were found at the scene of the theft.
