I do not have on hand and will not have at any time, fish, minnows, frogs, or other aquatic species except those legally obtained according to State of Oklahoma laws and rules of ODAFF and the Department Of Wildlife Conservation. In accordance with 2 O.S., § 6-313, all aquatic species shall be confined in such manner to prohibit wild species from becoming a part of the aquatic culture license holder's operations. Aquatic culture license holders are prohibited from making use of species furnished free by the state or Federal Government.

² The licensed operation shall assure that the aquatic species carcass disposal shall not violate the Oklahoma Criminal Code, Title 21 O.S. §§ 1222. Section 1222 states that it is unlawful to bury any carcasses in any land along any stream or ravine, where the carcasses may become exposed through erosion of the soil, or where the land is any time subject to overflow.
