Stolen Agriculture Report

County: Creek County

Investigative Services has received the following report:

Taken sometime between Saturday evening and daylight Sunday morning, about 2 miles east of intersection of Highways 48 and 16, east of Bristow in Creek County:

Ten (10) head of cattle, described as follows:

One (1) Gelbvieh/Angus Cross heifer, also known as a Balancer breed, ear tag (thought to be white) with the #135 on it, approximately 18 months old, weighing approximately 1,200 pounds, with metal bangs tag with the number 43-TNV3011 in it's ear.

Seven (7) black in color bred heifers, due to calve in approximately January/February, weighing approximately 1,000-1,100 pounds, with ear tags (thought to be orange) numbered 58, 59, 61, 62, 63, 64, 102.

Two (2) steers, black in color, weighing approximately 800 pounds, with ear tags (thought to be yellow) numbered 71 and 73.

None of the cattle were branded. Creek County S.O. has responded to the scene. Their case number is: 1658-15
