1-04-18**

Alfalfa trade and movement slow to moderate. Demand moderate to fairly good. Alfalfa supplies and offerings light to moderate. Buyers are actively looking at out-of-state sources for dairy and feedlot accounts. Grass hay demand showed slight improvement in central and western Oklahoma but mostly in small volume sales. Bitter cold weather moved into the state nearly two weeks ago and temperatures are just now moving above freezing. Very little moisture came with this winter weather and drought conditions have worsened dramatically.

Alfalfa

Central Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 125.00-140.00, mostly 130.00. Good quality large square bales mostly 100.00-120.00. Fair to Good quality round bales and few large square bales 85.00-110.00. Small square bales Premium Quality 10.00-12.50 per bale.

Eastern Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 125.00-140.00. Good quality large square alfalfa 100.00-120.00.

Western Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 130.00-140.00. Good quality 100.00-120.00, few round bales 80.00-110.00.
