OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

1-5-17

Alfalfa movement mostly moderate after the holidays. Grass hay movement remains mostly slow but slightly more active than in recent weeks. Cold weather and dry conditions have helped stimulate movement with increased supplemental feeding and drought concerns. Drought conditions have worsened in recent weeks as 83 percent of the state is in moderate to extreme drought. Only 5 percent of the state-all in extreme southwestern Oklahoma-report adequate moisture.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers not well tested for current delivery, however a lower undertone is noted. Movement is slow coming off of the holiday period. Many ranchers waiting to see how the market will open in the new year before making negotiations. Christmas holidays were unseasonably warm and dry but winter has returned bringing the first measurable snow of the season. Though a very dry snow it should be of some benefit to wheat pastures. Receipts this week consisted of 100 percent over 600 lbs and 44 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
