OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

1-19-17

Alfalfa movement moderate to fairly active after last weekend's winter storm. Demand was especially good for dry cow and bunk hay, mostly unchanged for Supreme and Premium quality. Grass hay demand was likewise improved and movement increased statewide. Northwestern Oklahoma is still recovering from the sever ice damage brought by the storm and many areas remain without power. Better news for central and eastern counties was that widespread rains of 1 to over 3 inches helped raise surface water and eased drought conditions. Most of the state still lags in overall moisture levels but conditions are improving for the time being.

Alfalfa

Central Oklahoma: Prices steady to 5.00 higher. Supreme quality large square bales 125.00-135.00. Premium quality large square bales 110.00-125.00, mostly 120.00-125.00. Untested hay moving to dairies, dry cow and bunk hay 90.00 to mostly 100.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Small square bales 11.00-14.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Prices firm to 5.00 higher. Premium quality large square bales mostly 120.00-125.00. Untested hay moving to dairies as well as bunk or dry cow hay 90.00-100.00.
