Alfalfa and hay trade movement was moderate this week but picking up in some parts of the Western region while still slow in other areas. All trades reported were mostly steady from last reported prices. Demand good with concerns of hay inventory dwindling down if cold and wet weather continues. Reports of moisture received varied from 3 tenths to a inch over the last week or so. All hay reported FOB Oklahoma unless otherwise noted.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers lightly tested but a lower undertone noted. Demand moderate. Supply consisted of 100 percent over 600 lbs and 38 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights.
