**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT  
1-26-17**

Receipts: 9,636      Last Week 5,087      Last Year 5,532

Alfalfa movement turned slow to moderate as immediate needs appear to have been met last week. Grass hay movement was mostly moderate although some areas continue to struggle with muddy conditions limiting hay hauling. Demand for dairy alfalfa moderate, demand for dry cow and bunk hay fairly good. Most offerings of dry cow and bunk hay appear to be in large round bales and most buyers looking for large squares. Last week's moisture softened the drought damage for portions of the state but rainfall levels still below normal so far this year.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers lightly tested on an FOB basis but traded steady to 3.00 higher, heifers not tested. Receipts this week consisted of 100 percent over 600 lbs and 25 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.

**Alfalfa**

Central Oklahoma: Prices steady in limited test. Supreme quality large square bales 125.00-135.00. Premium quality large square bales 110.00-125.00, mostly 120.00-125.00. Untested hay moving to dairies, dry cow and bunk hay 90.00 to mostly 100.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Small square bales 11.00-14.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Prices steady in limited test. Premium quality large square bales mostly 120.00-125.00. Untested hay moving to dairies as well as bunk or dry cow hay 90.00-100.00, no square bales confirmed at 90.00.

Central Oklahoma: Good Bermuda 4 X 5 bales 30.00-45.00 per bale, 5 X 6 bales 50.00-60.00. Prairie hay 4 X 5 bales 25.00-35.00 per bale.
