**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT
2-22-18**

Alfalfa trade moderate this week. Movement was mostly slow as winter storms brought rain, snow and ice to much of the state. Demand was generally good for all alfalfa, wheat and grass hay. Supplies of alfalfa are becoming extremely light. Prices only lightly tested this week but confirmed sales were fully steady on alfalfa. This week's precipitation is not expected to bring significant relief from the drought but will at least keep conditions from worsening. Wheat pastures across central and western Oklahoma continue to need more rain.

Central Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Fair to Good quality round and square bales 120.00-130.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 130.00-150.00.

Western Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 140.00-175.00, mostly 140.00-150.00. Fair quality large round and large square bales 125.00-135.00.

Grass Hay
