**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT**

**2-23-17**

Alfalfa movement slow to moderate this week under fairly good demand. Supplies are becoming harder to find and this seems to be fueling demand. Demand for good quality grass and wheat hay was moderate and supplies of this type hay also light to moderate. Supplies of low quality grass hay remain plentiful but demand is extremely light. More rainfall over all but the panhandle and extreme western edge of the state again this week. The moisture served to lessen drought conditions and most burn bans were temporarily removed at least for the short term.

**Alfalfa**

Central Oklahoma: Prices mostly steady except dry cow and bunk hay 10.00-20.00 higher. Supreme quality large square bales no sales confirmed. Premium quality large square bales no sales confirmed. Dry cow and bunk hay 110.00-120.00 instances 130.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Good quality dry cow and bunk hay round bales 80.00-90.00 per ton, 100.00-120.00 delivered short haul.

Small square bales 11.00-14.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Prices steady to 10.00 higher. Premium quality large square bales mostly 120.00-130.00. Untested hay moving to dairies as well as bunk or dry cow hay large square bales 110.00-130.00 per ton.
