Alfalfa trade and movement very light. Demand remains good to very good but supplies are extremely light. Most buyers now content waiting on new crop alfalfa. Majority of the state received minimal moisture this week in addition to colder than normal temperatures which has slowed new growth. The hay market was not fully tested but sales being reported were steady. Grass hay demand was good and movement moderate. Prices were steady. The bulk of remaining grass hay consists of mostly poor to fair quality mixed grass.

Eastern Oklahoma: No sales confirmed.
