Alfalfa trade very light on very light supplies. Movement was at a near standstill. Demand is very good and any alfalfa offered is immediately sold. Too few trades confirmed to establish trend this week but final sales moving sharply higher. Grass hay trading and movement were mostly moderate this week with most offerings of Fair quality mixed grass hay. Demand also very good for wheat straw although supplies of good wheat straw are very light. Central and eastern counties saw moisture supplies improve over the last two weeks and now need warmer weather to promote early grass growth.

Central Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 165.00-175.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: No sales confirmed.

Western Oklahoma: One load Supreme quality large square bales 190.00. Premium quality large square bales 170.00-175.00.

Grass Hay

CME cattle futures for both Live and Feeder cattle contracts were very uncertain again this week with drastic higher and lower movements. Receipts this week consisted of 90 percent over 600 lbs and 59 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
