OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

4-20-17

Alfalfa movement remains extremely light on very light supplies and moderate demand. New crop harvest will begin as soon as weather allows. More rains last week and continued rainfall this week is preventing haying of alfalfa and wheat hay. Prices have not been tested in recent weeks except on a few loads of grass hay and untested alfalfa. While green-up is here there are still a few areas reporting continued supplemental feeding of hay and cubes. Some agronomists are reporting wheat development is running as much as two weeks ahead of normal in parts of the state.

Alfalfa

Central Oklahoma: Prices largely untested. No sales Premium quality large square bales. Dry cow and bunk hay last confirmed sales 110.00-120.00 in large square bales.

Eastern Oklahoma: No sales confirmed.

Western Oklahoma: No trend established in light test. No sales of Premium or Supreme quality large square bales confirmed. Untested hay moving to dairies as well as bunk or dry cow hay large square bales last confirmed sales 100.00-130.00 per ton in large square bales, 80.00-100.00 in large round bales.

Grass Hay

Central Oklahoma: Good Bermuda 4 X 5 bales 30.00-45.00 per bale, 5 X 6 bales 50.00-60.00.

Western Oklahoma: Good quality wheat hay 5 X 6 bales 45.00-50.00/bale. Good Bermuda horse quality 65.00-70.00 per bale in 5 X 6 bales, Good Bermuda cow hay 5 X 6 bales 45.00-60.00 per bale, 4 X 5 bales mixed grass 40.00-45.00 per bale. Several loads sorghum sudangrass 5 X 6 bales 37.50 per bale.

Eastern Oklahoma: Mixed grass in 4 X 5 bales 20.00-30.00 per bale. Mixed grass hay in 5 X 6 bales 30.00-50.00. Good bluestem hay delivered 85.00-105.00 per ton. Good Bermuda in 5 X 6 bales 50.00-65.00 per bale. Good Bermuda 4 X 5 bales 25.00-45.00 per bale, mostly 25.00-35.00.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers traded 2.00-3.00 higher, feeder heifers not well tested for Current FOB trades but a higher undertone noted. Cattle futures opened the week higher increasing demand. Demand for feeder cattle remains very good. More rains have fallen at the end of the week and spring pastures are greening up nicely. Receipts this week consisted of 99 percent over 600 lbs and 42 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
