Many are into their first cutting of Alfalfa or have already completed it. Dairy hay is extremely slow as cutbacks are taking place in that industry as well. With warmer weather, Bermuda grass is just starting to show and producers expecting a first cutting of that hay come June. Some areas of the state are reportedly dry once again but rains storms expect to move thru over night.
