**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT  
6-1-17**

Hay trade moderate at best. Demand light to moderate for dairy quality alfalfa, moderate for dry cow, bunk hay and other offerings. More rains and thunderstorms once again disrupted haying and wheat harvest this week but producers in most areas are back in the field at this time. Grass haying is well underway in eastern counties but interest in most grass hay offerings fairly limited. Yields are highly variable with counties most affected by drought over the winter reporting much lower yields than average. Demand for wheat hay mostly moderate in central and western Oklahoma.
