Alfalfa trade and movement light to moderate. Prices mostly steady, few sales slightly higher on Good quality alfalfa. Alfalfa demand light to moderate. Some renewed interest being noted on Supreme quality alfalfa which is in very limited supply. Supplies of Premium quality offerings also becoming fairly light. Grass hay baling is still in full swing in central and eastern counties. Demand for grass hay light to moderate with supplies of 2016 hay still in the inventory. Hot, dry weather is taking a toll on grass hay yields this year. Also, wildfires have begun in central and eastern areas.

Central Oklahoma: Supreme quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Premium quality large square bales 120.00-130.00, instances 140.00. Good quality large square bales mostly 100.00-110.00. Fair to Good quality round bales and few large square bales 80.00-90.00. Small square bales 9.00-12.00 per bale.

Eastern Oklahoma: Small square bales horse hay 60-70 lb. bales 8.00 to 12.00, mostly 10.00-12.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales few sales 125.00-130.00. Good quality 90.00-100.00.

Grass Hay

Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights.
