**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT**

**8-03-17**

Alfalfa trade mostly slow and movement light to moderate. Alfalfa demand moderate from dairies, grinding alfalfa demand very light. Grass hay demand very light. Alfalfa prices holding steady as supplies of Supreme and Premium quality alfalfa are becoming harder to find. Cooler temperatures and light to moderate rain earlier this week brought relief from the heat but not much in the way of help for dryland alfalfa producers. Grass hay baling activities continue fairly active despite lack of demand.

Central Oklahoma: Supreme quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Premium quality large square bales 120.00-130.00, instances 140.00. Good quality large square bales mostly 100.00-110.00. Fair to Good quality round bales and few large square bales 80.00-90.00. Small square bales 9.00-12.00 per bale.

Eastern Oklahoma: Small square bales horse hay 60-70 lb. bales 8.00 to 12.00, mostly 10.00-12.00 per bale.
