Compared to two weeks ago: All classes of hay trade has been extremely slow due to recent heavy rains and cooler temperatures having producers hoping for a second cutting of Bermuda grass. Alfalfa trade also has been slow and getting cheaper as many dairies are looking for alternative feed stuffs. Stock cow producers are hoping the cooler and wetter weather will extend grazing into the Fall leaving less need to start stock piling hay. Demand mostly light to moderate.

Receipts: 4,259 Last Week 3,059 Last Year 5,584  
Compared to last week: Feeder steers lightly tested few trades 2.00 higher. Feeder heifers were not tested on a Current FOB Basis and no trend was available. Demand good. Supply consisted of 91 percent over 600 lbs and 81 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights.
