**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT**

**8-31-17**

Alfalfa trade moderate on moderate to good demand. Movement mostly moderate, instances fairly active in western and central Oklahoma. Prices are fully steady. Movement was also good on wheat hay in western counties. Grass hay demand and movement very light and supplies mostly burdensome. Third and fourth cutting of alfalfa still underway. Good rains and growing conditions also adding to grass supply and many producers still cutting and baling grass hay despite limited demand. Wheat planting expected to begin in next week to 10 days.

Central Oklahoma: Supreme quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Premium quality large square bales 125.00-140.00. Good quality large square bales mostly 100.00-110.00. Fair to Good quality round bales and few large square bales 80.00-90.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Small square bales horse hay 60-70 lb. bales mostly 10.00-12.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Supreme quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Premium quality large square bales few sales 125.00-130.00. Good quality 90.00-100.00.
