Alfalfa trade mostly slow to moderate as demand and movement turned slightly lighter this week. Dairy demand in particular turned lighter in the latter part of the week. Prices were fully steady in the limited test. Grass hay demand is very light with supplies heavy and continuing to grow. Baling activities continue active in much of central and eastern Oklahoma. Wheat planting is getting underway in western counties.

Central Oklahoma: Supreme quality large square bales 140.00-150.00. Premium quality large square bales 125.00-140.00. Good quality large square bales mostly 100.00-110.00. Fair to Good quality round bales and few large square bales 90.00-100.00.
